Summer Reading Project

For your project on The Chocolate Touch by Patrick Skene Catling, you will make a summary book which contains a chapter summary and illustration for all 12 chapters of the book. Your book will be shaped like a candy bar and must be uniquely decorated (be creative and have fun!).

The project is due on Tuesday, August 29, 2017. No projects will be accepted after the due date.

To make your book:

1. Fold a piece of construction paper "hot dog" style to make the cover.
2. Decorate the cover to look like a unique candy bar. The cover page needs to include the title of the book, the author and your name. Your name can be written on the back of the book if you prefer.
3. Fold 8 pieces of white printer paper "hot dog" style as well and place them inside of your cover. Staple together the cover and printer paper just below the fold.
4. Number the pages in the bottom right hand corner.
5. Find a scripture from the Bible that you think will help John with his problem of Greed. Write the scripture and reference on page 1.
6. Write a 4-6 sentence summary of each chapter on the numbered pages (beginning with page 2). Provide a hand-drawn illustration that shows a main idea from the chapter on the page above the summary.
7. On page 14 write what you thought of the book. What did you like? Would you recommend it to a friend?
8. On page 15 explain how the scripture from page 1 could have helped John Midas.
9. If God blessed you with the "Midas Touch" how would you use it for His glory? For example, if I had the "Midas Touch" I would go to starving nations and touch the ground to make it fertile. Everything put in the ground would grow and there would be no more hunger. Please answer the question on page 16.




